

**PECAN SHOW  
GENERAL RULES**

1. \$550.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Grand Champion Pecan entry. \$400.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Reserve Champion Pecan entry, and ribbons will be awarded in each variety division.
2. Pecans must be from exhibitor's 2023 crop.
3. **Entries will be accepted from Pecos County only.**
4. Each entry must consist of **42 pecans** of the same variety.
5. **Pecans will be exhibited in their natural state. Do not polish or attempt to alter color or shape.**
6. Pecans will be shown and judged by variety.
7. **Entries will be accepted until 9:00 a.m. November 30<sup>th</sup>.**
8. *All pecans become the property of the Pecos County Pecan Growers Assn.*
9. **Pecan entries will be available for public viewing after judging is complete on November 30<sup>th</sup>.**

**PECAN FOOD SHOW  
GENERAL RULES**

1. \$550.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Grand Champion food entries in both the Adult and Youth Divisions. \$400.00 cash prize will be awarded to the Reserve Champion entries in both Adult and Youth Divisions, and ribbons will be awarded in each division.
2. Pecans must be an ingredient in the recipe.
3. **The entire recipe must be entered for judging. In the "Cookies" and "Candy" divisions, please enter a sample of two dozen.**
4. All food **must** be in a disposable container. Pecos County Extension Office is **not** responsible for a non-disposable container.
5. Criteria: Difficulty of recipe will be considered in judging of product from ingredients used from scratch or convenient items.
6. Two (2) copies of the recipe must be submitted with each entry on 8½ x 11 sheets of paper. The division and category must be stated on recipe. Ex: Adult – Cakes, One with Name, One without Name.
7. There will be no limit on the number of entries per person.
8. Food entries can be brought to First National Bank between 8:00 - 9:00 a.m. on November 30<sup>th</sup>. Judging will begin at 9:15 a.m. on November 30<sup>th</sup>.
9. The Food Show will be open to the public after judging on November 30<sup>th</sup>.
10. The food categories, for both Adult and Youth divisions, which may be entered are
